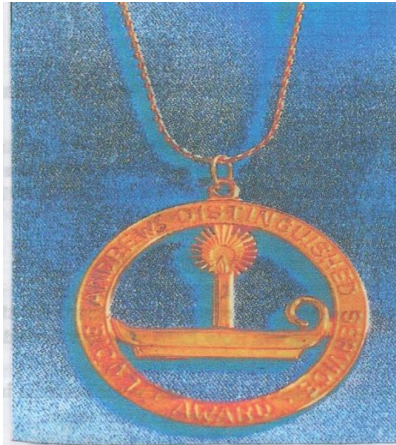

Ludie Clay Andrews Award Selection Criteria

- A. Record that indicates the applicant has made outstanding contributions in nursing Practice nursing education or nursing administration.
- B. Data that shows the applicant has demonstrated outstanding efforts to improve health care and/or health delivery.
- C. Documentation that the applicant has utilized good organization and managerial skills.
- D. The ability to communicate effectively with persons of various cultural/ethnic backgrounds is reflected in the date submitted.
- E. The applicant shall have been an active participant in her community, served as an initiator of health/human services related programs/projects of law-making body that impacts health care or healthcare delivery.
- F. Professional growth is evidenced by continuation of education and/or membership in professional organizations.
- G. Candidates shall have been active member of the conclave for four consecutive years.
